HOUSE AMENDMENT " B " to H. P. 1001, L. D. 1326, RESOLUTION,
Proposing an Amendment to the Constitution Providing for Early
Inauguration of the Governor.

Amend said Resolution in the 9th paragraph by adding at
the end before the period the following: 'and until his successor
has been duly elected and qualified' (same in L.D.)
