SENATE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1001, L.D. 1326, "RESOLUTION,

Amend said Resolve in that part designated "Constitution,  
Article IV, Part Third, Section 1" by striking out in the 6th line  
(same in L.D.) the underlined word "third"

Further amend said Resolve in that part designated "Constitution,  
Article IV, Part Third, Section 1" in the 6th line (same in L.D.)  
by inserting after the underlined word "Tuesday" the following  
underlined words: 'of the first full week'
