STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Change Name of Bureau of Labor and Industry to the Bureau of Labor.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. R. S., T. 26, § 41, amended. The first sentence of section 41 of Title 26 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended to read as follows:

A Bureau of Labor and Industry within the Department of Manpower Affairs, as heretofore established and hereinafter in this Title called the "bureau," shall be maintained under the direction of an officer whose title shall the Director of the Bureau of Labor and Industry and state factory inspector, hereinafter in this Title, except in chapter 13, called the "director."

Sec. 2. Amendatory provision. Wherever in the Revised Statutes the words "Bureau of Labor and Industry" appear, they shall mean the "Bureau of Labor." Wherever the word "director" meaning the "Director of the Bureau of Labor and Industry" appears, it shall mean the "Director of the Bureau of Labor," except in Title 26, chapter 13.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to change the name of the Bureau of Labor and Industry to the Bureau of Labor.
