AN ACT Relating to Collection of Excise Tax in Unorganized Places.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 36, § 1487, sub-§ 2, amended. The 2nd sentence of subsection 2 of section 1487 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

Such agents shall be allowed a fee of ~~300~~ \$1 for each tax receipt issued and shall deposit the remainder promptly with the county treasurer. **All taxes so collected in unorganized places shall be paid to the county where the taxpayer resides.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this bill to raise the fee paid to agents who collect the excise tax in unorganized places and to provide that all taxes collected under this section go to the county where the taxpayer resides.
