**AN ACT Relating to Open Season on Beaver on Passamaquoddy
Indian Lands.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 1960-B, additional. Title 12 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 1960-B to read as follows:

§ 1960-B. Beaver trapping by Passamaquoddy Indians

There shall be an open season on beaver during the months of January, February and December each year on all lands and islands belonging to the Passamaquoddy Tribe of Indians. It shall be unlawful for any person not a member of said Passamaquoddy Tribe to trap beaver during such open season on said Indian lands.
