**RESOLVE, in favor of George W. Mitchell of Peter Dana Township,
for Personal Injuries.**

George W. Mitchell; compensated. Resolved: That there be appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$20,000 for full and final reimbursement for losses caused George W. Mitchell from being wounded while in the line of duty as an employee of the Department of Indian Affairs and deputy sheriff in Eastport, Washington County, on September 10, 1967.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this resolve is to compensate George W. Mitchell for loss of income and permanent partial disability he sustained because he was shot on September 10, 1967. At the time he was shot while acting in the line of duty, Mr. Mitchell was employed by the State of Maine, Department of Indian Affairs and assigned to the Washington County Sheriff's Department. Mr. Mitchell was compensated for his medical expenses but has received no compensation for the nearly 2 years of work he lost nor for the permanent partial loss of the use of his left arm and the permanent numbness of the left side of his face caused by the wound.
