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**RESOLVE, Providing Funds for Portrait of Honorable Margaret Chase Smith.**

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**Margaret Chase Smith; funds for portrait. Resolved:** That the sum of \$5,000 be appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund for the commission of a portrait of the Honorable Margaret Chase Smith, the commissioning of and execution of to be under the supervision of the State Commission on the Arts and Humanities.

**STATEMENT OF FACT**

The purpose of this resolve is to give due honor to one of Maine's finest daughters, one of the nation's greatest women of the 20th Century, the only woman to have served in both Houses of Congress and the first woman to have been placed in nomination for President of the United States at a national convention of a major political party.
