COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to S. P. 436, L. D. 1340, Bill,
"AN ACT to Establish a State Veterans Home."

Amend said Bill in section 1 by striking out all of that part designated "§ 41." and inserting in place thereof the following:

'§ 41. Establishment

There is established in the State of Maine a home known as "Maine Veterans Home" primarily for support and care of honorably discharged veterans who served in the Armed Forces of the United States in any war, including the Korean and Viet Nam conflicts, and hereinafter in this subchapter referred to as members.'

Further amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated "§ 44." by striking out all of the last underlined sentence. (same in L.D)

Further amend said Bill in section 1 in that part designated "§ 45." by striking out in the 6th line (same in L.D.) the underlined figure "3" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '5' and by striking out in the 7th line (same in L.D.) the underlined word "suitable"

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to provide for a more suitable administration.
