HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1019, L. D. 1342, Bill, "AN ACT Increasing License Fee for Nurserymen."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R. S., T. 32, § 1901, amended. The 3rd sentence of section 1901 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The license fee shall be \$\frac{\$\pmathcap{5}}{2}\$ per year, excepting that for growers of strawberry, blackberry and raspberry plants, gladiolus, dahlias and herbaceous plants out-of-doors and whose total area of land devoted to those plants does not exceed 1/4 acre, there shall be no license fee.'

Statement of Fact

It is the intent of this amendment to increase the license fee for nurserymen thus producing approximately \$5,000 in General Fund revenue and to retain the annual licensing authority presently in the law for proper policing thereof.
