**AN ACT Increasing License Fee for Nurserymen.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 32, § 1901, amended.** The 2nd and 3rd sentences of section 1901 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes are amended to read as follows:

The form of license shall be prescribed by the State Horticulturist and the licenses shall be issued by him upon proper application therefor and shall expire on December 31st of ~~each~~ **the 3rd year after issuance**. The license fee shall be ~~\$1 per year~~ **\$5**, excepting that for growers of strawberry, blackberry and raspberry plants, gladiolus, dahlias and herbaceous plants out-of-doors and whose total area of land devoted to those plants does not exceed  $\frac{1}{4}$  acre, there shall be no license fee.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the license fee for nurserymen from \$1 for one year to \$5 for 3 years.
