STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Increasing License Fee for Nurserymen.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 32, § 1901, amended. The 2nd and 3rd sentences of section 1901 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes are amended to read as follows:

The form of license shall be prescribed by the State Horticulturist and the licenses shall be issued by him upon proper application therefor and shall expire on December 31st of each the 3rd year after issuance. The license fee shall be \$1 per year \$5, excepting that for growers of strawberry, blackberry and raspberry plants, gladiolus, dahlias and herbaceous plants out-of-doors and whose total area of land devoted to those plants does not exceed ¼ acre, there shall be no license fee.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to increase the license fee for nurserymen from \$1 for one year to \$5 for 3 years.
