HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H.P. 1021, L.D. 1344, Bill,
"AN ACT Amending the Law Relating to the Provision of Housing
and Meals to State Employees."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end of section 2,
before the period, the following underlined words:

'and when the state employee involved receives a salary less
than the salary received by an employee at pay range 21, merit
service step E of the compensation plan for classified employees'
