the underlined words and punctuation",which leads to conviction,"

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 2nd line of  
the 2nd paragraph (same in L.D.) the underlined words and punctu-  
ation ",upon conviction,"

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is allow forfeit of the right  
to plead guilty to a lesser charge before conviction rather than  
after.
