COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A" to H. P. 1030, L. D. 1352,
Bill, "AN ACT Changing the Number of Parole Board Members and
Modifying the Qualifications for Eligibility for Appointment."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 1551." by striking out in the 5th line (4th and 5th lines of L.D.) the following: "State. Two-of-the The members" and inserting in place thereof the following: 'State:--Two-of-the-members, who'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§ 1551."

by striking out in the 9th line (7th and 8th lines in L.D.) the underlined words "and familiarity with the problems of institutionalized persons"

Further amend said Bill by striking out in the 6th line before the Statement of Fact (5th in L.D.) the underlined figure "4" and inserting in place thereof the underlined figure '3'

Further amend said Bill by inserting before the Statement of Fact the following:

'Sec. 2. Appropriation. There is appropriated to the State Parole Board from the General Fund the sum of \$14,590 to carry out the purposes of this Act. The breakdown shall be as follows:

Statement of Fact

The purposes of this amendment are to delete the additional requirement that a parole board member have familiarity with the problems of institutionalized persons, to change the quorum number from 4 to 3, clarification and to provide the necessary appropriation to carry out the purposes of the bill.
