HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1037, L. D. 1357, Bill, "AN ACT Authorizing Food Stamp Program for Certain Municipalities."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end before the period and before the statement of fact, the following underlined words:

'under the same conditions as would a county electing to participate'

Statement of Fact

There is a bill (L.D. 207) which, if passed, would call for 50% county funding and 50% state, with the exception of issuing costs. This bill, as written, doesn't allow for that. If L.D. 207 passed, question could be raised as to paying 50% of the costs to a local municipality when the bill says only county.
