AN ACT Authorizing Food Stamp Program for Certain Municipalities.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 22, § 3104, amended. Section 3104 of Title 22 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed and replaced by section 1 of chapter 463 of the public laws of 1971, is amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

If any county fails to apply for a food stamp program, a municipality having a population of 20,000 or more and located in such county may make such application and elect to participate in such a program.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to permit a municipality of 20,000 or more to participate in a food stamp program, if the county in which the municipality is located fails to so participate.
