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**AN ACT** Relating to the Registration of Private Employment Agencies.

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 2651, amended. Section 2651 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end the following new sentences:

Upon receipt of such license from the municipal officers of the city or town where such employment agency is to be located, each such person, persons, or chief officers thereof if a corporation, shall be required to register with the Bureau of Labor and Industry in Augusta. The licensee shall inform said bureau of the name of the person licensed, the full address of the house or building in which the licensee is authorized to carry on an employment agency, including the number and street, the name of the city or town, and the zip code and the telephone number of the agency. Failure to register with the said bureau may result in the loss of the license to carry on an employment agency in this State.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the purpose of this bill to require all employment agencies to register with the Bureau of Labor and Industry. No additional funds are required.
