IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Permitting Sealed Tickets to Promote Attendance on Premises of Liquor Club Licensees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 28, § 305, amended. The last paragraph of section 305 of Title 28 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 372 of the public laws of 1969, is amended to read as follows:

Nothing in this section shall be construed to prohibit a licensed club from offering prizes, sealed tickets, gratuities or other inducements, otherwise legal, as a means of promoting attendance on licensed premises.
