STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse Bass Shoe Employees Federal Credit Union for Damage to Property by Escapees of Women's Correctional Center.

Bass Shoe Employees Federal Credit Union; reimbursed. Resolved: There is appropriated from the Unappropriated Surplus of the General Fund the sum of \$321.02 to be paid to Bass Shoe Employees Federal Credit Union of Wilton, as a full and final settlement, for damage to motor vehicle of Mrs. Olene Lee of Weld incurred by escapees from the Women's Correctional Center.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Mrs. Lee's motor vehicle was taken in February, 1971 by 4 escapees of the Women's Correctional Center. The car was damaged to the amount of \$321.02, which loss was sustained by the credit union. The escapees were apprehended in Lewiston.
