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**AN ACT to Permit Log Landings Along Route Numbered Public Roads.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 519, sub-§ 9, additional. Section 519 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 486 of the public laws of 1971, is amended by adding a new subsection 9 to read as follows:

9. Areas not closer than 1,000 feet apart and not larger than 100-foot frontage on a numbered road used for log and pulpwood landings.
