AN ACT Exempting Blind Property Owners from Real Property Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 36, § 656, sub-§ 1, ¶ G, additional. Subsection 1 of section 656 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new paragraph G to read as follows:

G. The residential real estate up to the value of \$3,000 of inhabitants of Maine who are legally blind as determined by the Department of Health and Welfare, provided the value of such real estate does not exceed \$10,000. If the value exceeds \$10,000 but not more than \$20,000, the exemption shall be \$2,000.
