COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A" to H. P. 1050, L. D. 1369, RESOLVE,  
Designating Augusta Bridge as "Father John J. Curran Bridge."

Amend said Resolve by striking out in the 7th, 8th and 9th lines (5th, 6th and 7th in L. D.) the following "bridge be erected and maintained by the Department of Transportation at such location as the Department of Transportation shall select" and inserting in place thereof the following 'bridge may be erected and maintained at no expense to the State and subject to the approval of the Department of Transportation'
