RESOLVE, Designating Augusta Bridge as "Father John J. Curran Bridge."

Augusta bridge designated. Resolve: That in recognition of the outstanding and unselfish service of Father John J. Curran to the Augusta area, the bridge reconstructed across the Kennebec River between Bridge Street and Cony Hill in Augusta be named the "Father John J. Curran Bridge," and that an appropriate plaque designating the name of the bridge be erected and maintained by the Department of Transportation at such location as the Department of Transportation shall select.
