**RESOLVE, Relating to Retirement Benefit for Frederick E. Freise
of Portland.**

Frederick E. Freise; retirement. Resolved: That Frederick E. Freise of Portland be granted credit for the years he has worked at the University of Maine and that said years be credited to his Maine Retirement System account.

STATEMENT OF FACT

Mr. Freise has worked in education for this State continuously since 1947 and has a total of 19½ years under the state retirement plan plus 9 years under College Retirement Equity Fund.

When the new super university system was formed, the teachers college employees who were under the state plan were given an option to stay with the state plan or join College Retirement Equity Fund. He was not given this option and feels that he is being penalized to be under 2 separate retirement plans considering the fact that he has been working for the State continuously all these years. He believes that he should be entitled to the same choice given the teachers college employees when the new super university was formed.
