STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Appropriating Funds to Educate and Rehabilitate Persons Handicapped by Deafness.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Department of Health and Welfare; appropriation. There is appropriated to the Department of Health and Welfare from the General Fund the sum of \$160,000 to provide special rehabilitation and vocational services to the deaf. To assure program coordination and effectiveness, personnel funded by this Act shall work in cooperation with the Baxter School for the Deaf. All funds appropriated under this Act shall be available to the extent they are matched by federal funds. The breakdown shall be as follows:

The State appropriated funds shall be reduced if federal matching funds become available.
