HOUSE AMENDMENT"A " to S.P. 417, L.D. 1378, Bill, "AN ACT to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Education Laws."

Amend said Bill by insertin after section 39 the following:

'Sec. 39-A. R.S.,T. 20, §1902, amended. The first sentence
of section 1902 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as repealed
and replaced by chapter 177 of the public laws of 1967 and as
amended by chapter 255 of the public laws of 1973, is amended to
read as follows:

Whenever any certified teacher completes, within any 2-year period, 6 credit hours of additional professional work approved by the superintendent, the teacher shall receive an amount of not less than \$100 from the administrative unit-except-that-the-foregoing-provision-shall-not-apply-to-a-certified-teacher-who;-at-the-time-of completion-of-such-6-credit-hours;-is-represented-by-a-bargaining agent-under-Title-26;-chapter-9-A.

Sec. 39-B. R.S.,T.20, §1902, amended. The 2nd sentence of of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes section 1902 as enacted by chapter 177 of the public laws of 1967 and as / repealed by chapter 255 of the public laws of 1973 is reenacted to read as follows:

Expenditures for this purpose shall be included as a proper cost in calculating expenditures which may be reimbursed by the State under the foundation program as defined in section 3731.

Sec. 39-C. Effective date. Sections 39-A and 39-B of this Act shall become effective 91 days after adjournment of the Legislature.

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to repeal chapter 255 of the public laws of 1973 which has been declared to be unconstitutional by the office of the Attorney General.
