SENATE AMENDMENT "C " to S. P. 417, L. D. 1378, Bill, "AN ACT
to Correct Errors and Inconsistencies in the Education Laws."

Amend said Bill by inserting after section 7 the following:

'Sec. 7-A. R. S., T. 20, §51, sub-§1, amended. Subsection 1
of section 51 of Title 20 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by
section 4 of chapter 610 of the public laws of 1971, is amended
by adding at the end the following new sentence:
Members of the board shall serve without pay, other than their
actual expenses while carrying out the functions of the board.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to reenact a provision which
was inadvertently repealed in the reorganization of the State Board
of Education.
