HOUSE AMENDMENT "A" to H.P. 1051, L.D. 1380, Bill, "AN ACT
Relating to Tread Depth of Motor Vehicle Tires."

Amend said Bill in that part designated "§1371-A." by striking
out all of the first paragraph of subsection 1, and inserting in
place thereof the following:

'1. Tire requirements. No motor vehicle shall receive an
inspection sticker unless it is equipped with tires in safe operating
condition in accordance with requirements established by this chapter.
No tire mounted on a motor vehicle shall be deemed to be in safe
operating condition unless it meets the visual and tread depth
requirements set forth in this section.'

Further amend said Bill in that part designated "§1371-A."
by striking out all of subparagraph (4) of paragraph B, and inserting
in place thereof the following:

'(4) Any tire with the sidewalls damaged to the extent
that the body cords are damaged.'
