COMMITTEE AMENDMENT " A " to H. P. 1057, L. D. 1381, Bill,
"AN ACT Relating to Deceptive Price Comparison Advertising under

Amend said Bill in the 2nd and 5th lines before the Statement
of Fact (same in L.D.) by striking out the underlined figure
and word "30-day" and inserting in place thereof the underlined
figure and word '60-day'
