SENATE AMENDMENT "B " to H.P. 1057, L.D. 1381, Bill, "AN ACT  
Relating to Deceptive Price Comparison Advertising under Uniform  
Deceptive Trade Practices Act."


Amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line  
after the enacting clause (same in L.D.) the underlined abbreviation  
and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Bill by inserting at the end, before the  
Statement of Fact, the following section:

'Sec. 2. Effective date. This Act shall become effective on  
September 15, 1974.'
