STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Failure to File a Campaign Report.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 21, § 1398, sub-§ 1, amended. Subsection 1 of section 1398 of Title 21 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

1. Disqualified. If the assessment is not paid at the order of the committee, the person becomes disqualified and his name shall not be printed on an official ballot used at any election held during the same ealendar year term of the office for which he was a candidate, and the person shall be disqualified to hold the office to which he was elected.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to disqualify for office those who fail to file a campaign report.
