STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Require the Grantee's Address on any Deed Presented for Recording.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 33, § 456, amended. Section 456 of Title 33 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by chapter 57 of the public laws of 1971, is amended to read as follows:

§ 456. Address of buyer

All deeds and other instruments for the conveyance of real property before recording in the registries of deeds shall contain, in addition to the name of the grantee, his address, including street and number, municipality and state.
