AN ACT Exempting Tuberculosis Health Associations from the Sales Tax.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 36, § 1760, sub-§ 16-A, additional. Section 1760 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 16-A to read as follows:

16-A. Tuberculosis health associations. Sales to tuberculosis health associations which provide care and treatment for their patients.

FISCAL NOTE

The revenue loss is minimal.
