SENATE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 1067, L.D. 1392, Bill, "AN ACT Requiring that the ~~National School~~ Lunch Program be Implemented in All Public Schools."

Amend said Bill in the 5th line of section 1 (same in L.D.) by inserting after the underlined words "public schools" the following underlined words and punctuation: ',except high schools,'


Statement of Fact
