SENATE AMENDMENT" B " H.P. 1067, L.D. 1392, Bill, "AN ACT  
Requiring that the National School Lunch Program be Implemented  
in All Public Schools."

Amend said Bill by inserting at the end of section 2 and  
before the Fiscal Note, the following underlined subsection:


'5. Exception.

A. Definition. For the purposes of this chapter, "high  
school" shall mean a school limited to students in grades  
9, 10, 11 and 12.

B. High schools excepted. Nothing in this chapter shall  
be construed to require the participation of any high  
school, as defined in paragraph A, in the National School  
Lunch Program.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is to exempt high  
schools from mandatory lunch programs due to difficulties  
in scheduling but not to preclude such schools from volun-  
tary programs.
