HOUSE AMENDMENT " A " to HOUSE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 1068, L. D. 1393, Bill, "AN ACT Exempting Fuels Used to Heat Commercial Broiler Houses from the Sales Tax."

Amend said Amendment by striking out all of the first paragraph and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Amend said Bill in the Title by striking out the words "Broiler Houses" and inserting in place thereof the words 'Poultry Houses and Potato Warehouses'

Further amend said Amendment by inserting after the first paragraph the following:

'Further amend said Bill by inserting at the beginning of the first line after the enacting clause (same in L. D.) the underlined abbreviation and figure 'Sec. 1.'

Further amend said Amendment by inserting before the Statement of Fact (same in L. D.) the following:

'Further amend said Bill by inserting before the Fiscal Note (same in L. D.) the following:

'Sec. 2. R. S., T. 36, § 1760, sub-§ 9-C, additional. Section 1760 of Title 36 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 9-C to read as follows:

<u>9-C. Heating potato warehouses. Coal, oil, wood and</u> all other fuels, when bought for heating buildings in which potatoes are commercially kept.' '
