**AN ACT** Allowing Municipalities to Insure Against Personal  
Liability of Their Officers, Officials and Employees.

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 30, § 5102, sub-§ 5, amended. Subsection 5 of section 5102 of Title 30 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding at the end a new paragraph to read as follows:

Insuring its officers, officials and employees against any personal liability which they may incur out of and in the course of their acting by, for or on behalf of the municipality while in performance of their duties as public officers, officials and employees. Said liability shall not exceed the limits of coverage of said insurance or \$100,000, whichever is the greater amount.

STATEMENT OF FACT

This bill encourages municipalities to insure their public officers, officials and employees against liability arising from their acts as municipal officers, officials and employees.
