COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H. P. 1071, L. D. 1396,  
Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Mirrors on Certain Vehicles."

Amend said Bill by striking out all of the last underlined paragraph before the Statement of Fact (same in L. D.) and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Whenever an automobile to which temporary outside mirrors have been attached for the purpose of permitting an unobstructed view to the rear when towing a trailer or semitrailer is operated when not towing a trailer or semitrailer, such temporary rear view mirrors shall be removed or otherwise adjusted so as not to extend beyond the width of the automobile.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this bill is to remove mirrors from cars when the car is not used to haul trailers as a matter of safety.
