AN ACT Relating to Mirrors on Certain Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 1367, amended. Section 1367, of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding at the end the following new paragraph:

Whenever a vehicle, which hauls or partially carries a trailer or semi-trailer, is unhooked from the trailer or semitrailer, the mirror or mirrors on the vehicle must be removed.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to remove mirrors from cars when car is not in use to haul trailers as a matter of safety.
