STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to the Erection of a Sign on Maine Turnpike for the Evergreen Valley Recreational Area.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 23, § 1201, sub-§ 25, additional. Section 1201 of Title 23 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new subsection 25 to read as follows:

25. Evergreen Valley Area: Such sign shall be constructed and maintained on the Maine Turnpike no less than 7 miles southerly from exit 7 and shall be worded as follows:

EVERGREEN VALLEY RECREATIONAL AREA — EXITS 8 and 11 STONEHAM — LOVELL.

STATEMENT OF FACT

In accordance with long-standing policy and practice of the State of Maine, the purpose of this Act is to facilitate the flow of traffic on the highways and turnpikes of the State and to guide the users thereof to a major recreational area of the State.

Evergreen Valley is an area situated in the Towns of Stoneham and Lovell in which are located lakes, mountains and rivers and where uses such as boating, swimming, canoeing, hunting, fishing, hiking, skiing, mountain climbing, ski-mobiling and most forms of outdoor recreation for all seasons of the year have been developing and are developing.

Evergreen Valley is rapidly increasing in popularity and the proposed amendment would be of great service to the travelling public.
