**AN ACT Prohibiting the Stopping of School Buses at No-passing Zones on
2-lane Highways.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 29, § 2011, amended. Section 2011 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as amended, is further amended by adding a new paragraph after the 7th paragraph, to read as follows:

The driver of a school bus in stopping on a 2-lane highway, for the purpose of receiving or discharging any school children, must not stop such school bus in a no-passing zone for motor vehicles.
