**AN ACT to Reconstitute and Place a Public Member on the Maine Real Estate Commission.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., T. 32, § 4051, amended.** The first sentence of section 4051 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The Maine Real Estate Commission, as heretofore established and in this chapter called the "commission," shall consist of ~~3~~ **5** persons appointed by the Governor, each of whom shall be a resident of the State and who, immediately prior to the date of his appointment, shall have been a resident of the State for 5 years ~~and whose vocation for a period of at least 10 years shall have been that of a real estate broker or a real estate salesman.~~ **There shall be 4 members of the commission whose vocations for a period of at least 5 years shall have been that of real estate brokers and one public member whose vocation shall always have been other than real estate.**

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this bill to recompose the Maine Real Estate Commission to include 4 real estate brokers and a public member of an unrelated field instead of all realtors.
