STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Reconstitute and Place a Public Member on the Maine Real Estate Commission.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 32, § 4051, amended. The first sentence of section 4051 of Title 32 of the Revised Statutes is amended to read as follows:

The Maine Real Estate Commission, as heretofore established and in this chapter called the "commission," shall consist of 3 5 persons appointed by the Governor, each of whom shall be a resident of the State and who, immediately prior to the date of his appointment, shall have been a resident of the State for 5 years and whose vocation for a period of at least 10 years shall have been that of a real estate broker or a real estate salesman. There shall be 4 members of the commission whose vocations for a period of at least 5 years shall have been that of real estate brokers and one public member whose vocation shall always have been other than real estate.

STATEMENT OF FACT

It is the intent of this bill to recompose the Maine Real Estate Commission to include 4 real estate brokers and a public member of an unrelated field instead of all realtors.
