STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Carrying Persons on Passenger Tramway.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 25, § 1906, additional. Title 25 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 1906 to read as follows:

§ 1906. Prohibition

No person shall be permitted to carry another person up or down a passenger tramway.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The purpose of this bill is to prohibit the carrying of children on the backs of adults while the adults are skiing.
