COMMITTEE AMENDMENT" A" to H.P. 1091, L.D. 1423, Bill, "AN ACT Limiting Positions of Trust for Prisoners in Jails to Those Prisoners Sentenced to that Particular Jail."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and inserting in place thereof the following:

'R.S., T. 34, § 952-A, additional. Title 34 of the Revised Statutes is amended by adding a new section 952-A to read as follows:

§ 952-A. Positions of trust for certain prisoners

Positions of trust may be granted by a sheriff only to a prisoner confined in a jail who was sentenced to serve his term in that particular jail.'

Statement of Fact

The purpose of this amendment is clarification and to remove the provisions for petition by the sheriff to the Superior Court or District Court for a waiver of the restriction imposed by the bill being amended.
