**AN ACT** Relating to Name of Maine Commercial Fisheries.

---

**Emergency preamble.** Whereas, Acts of the Legislature do not become effective until 90 days after adjournment unless enacted as emergencies; and

Whereas, Maine Commercial Fisheries will supply a much needed internal communication to inform the industry of the developments and problems within the industry; and

Whereas, the following legislation is vitally necessary to prevent the loss of job opportunities and to develop Maine's rich marine resources to its full potential; and

Whereas, in the judgment of the Legislature, these facts create an emergency within the meaning of the Constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now, therefore,

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**Maine Commercial Fisheries; use of name granted.** The Maine Commercial Fisheries, which will be incorporated as a nonprofit corporation, is granted the authority to use the name "Maine Commercial Fisheries."

**Emergency clause.** In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this Act shall take effect when approved.

**STATEMENT OF FACT**
