

## STATE OF MAINE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES 106TH LEGISLATURE

COMMITTEE AMENDMENT"A" to H. P. 1097, L. D. 1434, Bill, "AN ACT Relating to Motorcycle Operators' Licenses."

Amend said Bill by striking out everything after the enacting clause and before the Statement of Fact and inserting in place thereof the following:

'<u>R. S., T. 29, § 583, amended.</u> Section 583 of Title 29 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by section 18 of chapter 425 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended by adding after the 2nd paragraph a new paragraph to read as follows:

After September 1, 1975 no motorcycle or motor driven cycle learner's permit or operator's license, or both, shall be issued to any person under 18 years of age, unless such person shall present a certificate of successful completion of a motorcycle driver education course and examination given by some person or persons licensed by the Secretary of State.'

## Statement of Fact

The purpose of this legislation is to increase the skills of persons riding motorcycles by establishing training programs for persons before they get their licenses.
