COMMITTEE AMENDMENT "A " to H.P. 1101, L.D. 1437, Bill, "AN ACT to Establish a Cooperative Education Support Program."

Amend said Bill in the 5th line of that part designated "§1901." (4th line of L.D.) by striking out the underlined word "accredited"

Further amend said Bill in the 3rd paragraph of that part designated "§1903." (same in L.D.) by adding at the end a new sentence to read as follows:

'Priority will be given to Maine residents.'
