STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT to Prohibit Lobster Fishing on Saturday During June, July and August.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 12, § 4458, amended. The last sentence of the first paragraph of section 4458 of Title 12 of the Revised Statutes, as amended by chapter 327 of the public laws of 1967, is further amended to read as follows:

From June 1st to August 31st of each year, during the period from 4 p.m., Eastern Daylight Saving Time, on Saturday Friday to $\frac{1}{2}$ hour before sunrise of the following Monday morning, it is unlawful for any person to raise, haul or transfer from the tidal waters of this State any pot, trap or other contrivance that is set for the taking of lobsters or crabs.

STATEMENT OF FACT

The intent of this Act is reflected in the title.
