STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
SEVENTY-THREE

AN ACT Relating to Establishment of Police Certification Program by Maine
Law Enforcement and Criminal Justice Academy.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., T. 25, § 2803, amended. Section 2803 of Title 25 of the Revised Statutes, as enacted by section 1 of chapter 491 of the public laws of 1969, and as last repealed and replaced by section 12 of chapter 592 of the public laws of 1971, is amended by adding a new paragraph at the end to read as follows:

The board of trustees of the academy shall establish a police certificate program and set standards for the award of such certificates to law enforcement officers in recognition of their training and educational accomplishments.
